The above patient of ours has a long history of complex mental health issues culminating in severe suicidal ideation. As a result she has been under the care of the mental health services for many years to provide the support she needs. Diagnoses of recurrent depressive disorder and personality disorder have been made. She remains on long term medication to alleviate the symptoms.

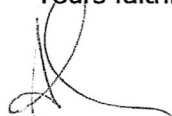
Until November 2015 she was under regular review by a psychiatrist and we continue to see her to review her symptoms on a 4 weekly basis.

As a result of her condition she is very forgetful and needs prompting with activities of daily living. She needs some support with potentially dangerous tasks. She therefore pays for help at home to help carry out daily activities. She needs reminders such as cooking and cleaning and to take her medications.

I have to say that since she has had more support at home with her mental health has improved. I feel that she is a vulnerable person and withdrawal of PIP could have a detrimental effect on her mental health.
